Dear Visitors, Exhibitors and Concessionaires:

Welcome to the 2024 Allentown Art Festival. This is our third live show following two years of pandemic on line shows. Each live festival has seen greater joy and energy than the year before, and that the momentum continues this year. You will see compositions from 350 artists of all types.

We once again extend a warm welcome as we gather in downtown Buffalo's historic Allentown neighborhood to celebrate the visual arts. The charm of Allentown, the uniqueness and quality of the arts and crafts, and Buffalo's reliably gorgeous June weather combine to make this an exciting, memorable, and just plain fun weekend. Now in our 67th year, the Allentown Art Festival continues as one of Buffalo's most venerated and well-attended annual events.

Every year brings new changes and improvements. We welcome the Corning Glass Museum with its displays and demonstrations. CEPA Gallery will bring its photo lab. The Hunt Gallery and Allentown Art Festival will be presenting works by emerging artists. This year will also include metal smithing and pottery demonstrations. Buffalo State will once again be hosting a pottery demonstration. This year's food and music is greatly expanded, with the addition of food trucks on Franklin Street, new concessionaires, and a live music in front of the Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural Site. Visit Buffalo Niagara will have a tent on Allen and Delaware.

This year, we decided to forego the paper edition of our annual Show Guide in favor of an on line one. You can find the Festival map, the list of artists and where they are located, and all of the other information that we published in the paper guide at our website, www.allentownartfestival.com, which you can access from your phone. If you miss the paper version, please let us know. The website includes a link to the Festival Store, where you can purchase t-shirts, sweatshirts, tote bags, posters, baby apparel, exercise clothing, organic apparel and so much more, adorned with vintage designs from as early as 1964. You can stay connected with us by following us on Facebook, Instagram, X (formerly Twitter), and YouTube.

Along with my fellow Board Members, I am honored and pleased to carry on the Art Festival's tradition that has evolved in so many ways over so many years. Since 1958, this all-volunteer group has brought together art, artists, art lovers, festival lovers, food lovers, and so many others, to produce a top-notch show of arts and crafts, and to actively foster participation and support among artists and cultural institutions. We offer prize awards, art scholarships and art projects in Buffalo's Public Schools. We also support aspiring young artists with the Locust Street Neighborhood Art Classes. As a non-profit organization, we earn our money from our wonderful exhibitors, and we return it to the local community.

This Festival has become Buffalo's "Annual Rite of Spring." If you are visiting Western New York, please stay a few extra days, or return soon, to enjoy local cultural activities, natural wonders and relics of our historic past. We have a wonderful waterfront, including Canalside, wonderful museums, parks, historic architecture, special places and celebrations that are so abundant and unique to Buffalo Niagara.

We don't think you should miss a minute of the festival, but if you find yourself with a little extra time, take a drive or walk by the newly renamed Buffalo AKG Art Museum at 1285 Elmwood Avenue. It's grand opening last year attracted world attention after a staggering \$230 million capital campaign. The new glass structure connects to the gallery by sky bridge, and there is a new courtyard. Two major architectural magazines listed it among the most anticipated projects of 2023.

We welcome with open arms both newcomers and longtime patrons. We hope that each of you absorb all of the art, concessions, music, entertainment and all-around fun offered by this nationally-renowned festival.

Finally, we extend thanks to our 60-plus volunteer working members, to the City of Buffalo and other governmental bodies, and to the Allentown business community and residents. Their essential help and cooperation help make the Festival an annual success.

The Allentown Art Festival would like you to know where our net revenues go. Here is a look at recent past years. Since 1991, these organizations have benefited because you supported the Allentown Art Festival each year:

Prizes to Exhibitors

The Allentown Art Festival presents cash prizes to exhibitors each year of over \$18,000 in total, within each category of art including painting, sculpture, glass, drawing & graphics, jewelry, etc. Since 1991, the Allentown Art Festival has given over \$500,000 in prize money to the artists.

Scholarships Totaling More Than \$300,000.

The Allentown Art Festival Scholarship Program awards scholarships to high school seniors enrolling in arts programs at colleges and universities, as well as students continuing their art programs during their sophomore, junior and senior years. The Allentown Art Festival Scholarship Program also provides scholarships for high school students within the eight counties of Western New York participating in the New York State Summer School for the Arts program.

About the Poster Art Competition And Winners

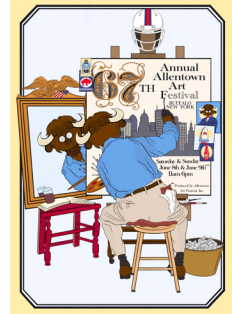

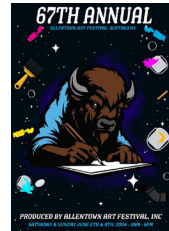

2024 Judges



Don J. Siuta has been involved in the arts in WNY for over 45 years. He attended Buffalo State College where he majored in Art Education & minored in Art History. He also studied painting, photography & design. Mr Siuta is the founder & director of Art Dialogue Gallery. He was the primary organizer & founding member of the WNY Artist Group, a not-for-profit community based arts membership organization that represents over 250 artists in the area. As an arts administrator he has served on various committees & boards related to the arts & has juried, judged & curated many exhibitions throughout WNY. Mr Siuta lectures extensively & has been an adjunct professor at Canisius College, State University of NY at Buffalo & State University at Buffalo. Since 1994 he has served on the Board of Directors of the City of Buffalo Arts Commission & currently is the chair of the City's Art & Monument Conservation & Restoration Committee. Previously he was a board member of Artists Gallery, Buffalo Society of Artists, Arts Parts & the Allentown Association. In December of 2023 Don was appointed by County Executive Mark Poloncarz to the newly formed Erie County Art in Public Places Committee.

As an artist Mr Siuta has had a solo exhibitions at the Buffalo Club & at the former Arts Council of Buffalo & Erie County. He is an exhibiting member of the WNY Artists Group & the Buffalo Society of Artist. His work can be found at Art Dialogue Gallery & at the Collector's Gallery at AKG. His artwork included in various collections including the permanent collection of the Birchfield Penney Art Center. Mr Siuta is adept at curated exhibitions.



Dr. Gerald Mead is an independent curator, art collector & arts writer who recently retired from teaching in the Art & Design Department of the Buffalo State University. He is a leading authority on WNY art & received his MFA in Visual Studies from the University at Buffalo, where he was a Dean's Scholar. As a former longtime curator at the Burchfield Penney Art Center, Mead organized over 130 exhibitions, some of which toured nationally. He is an appointed member of the Buffalo Arts Commission, serves on several art committees & boards in the region & frequently juries local & national art exhibitions. Mead's own artwork is in the collections of Buffalo AKG Art Museum, George Easement Museum, Castellani Art Museum, Oregon State University, Sprint Foundation & the International Museum of College, Assemblage & Construction in Santa Fe, NM among others. Mead's works have been in museum & gallery exhibitions throughout the US & in Australia, Canada, China, England, Poland & Russia & are published in six collegiate textbooks. He has also lectured on his work at Cambridge University, Chautauqua Institution & several SUNY Colleges & University & received grants from the New York Foundation for the Arts & the New York State Council for the Arts.



George Grace is a visual artist working mainly with pastels & acrylics. He has won awards in three of the past four regional WNY art exhibitions: two Best of Shows in Buffalo's Fine Arts League (Blast Furnaces Under a Shrouded Moon & Watching the Sunrise) and Second Place in the Pastel Society of WNY exhibition at the Kenan Center. (Through the Rain-Blurred Windshield) He is a four term past president of the Buffalo Society of Artists. Many of the paintings in his Steel Plant Series comes from photos he took while working as an electrician prior to the massive layoff or 1977, and from photos he's taken of the nature reclaimed ruins of the Coke Ovens some forty year's after the closing, many are in the WNY Steel Plant Museum & were exhibited at the Burchfield Penney Art Center.

He has also written several articles, including in Pastel Journal & Art Calendar, had taught numerous writing and art workshops & private, lessons, and has judged dozens of art exhibitions & festivals. When not painting, he writes poetry & had six plays produced locally. His art is included in numerous private & public collections nationally.



Melinda K. Schneider - I'm interested in the many aspects of reflection - what exists on the other, or opposite side. This influence can be seen in self-portraits, though the looking glass, in puddles or large bodies of water, shiny objects in the night skies, or any elements which are reflective, either literally or figuratively. Many of my pieces harbor an alternative dimension. I have considered myself an artist since I was a small child & I majored in Art in both High School & college at Buffalo State.

Over the years, I have studied privately with artists in Buffalo & with Max Schertz in San Francisco, while working as an artist & crafts person painting murals, in addition to the design & creation of custom clothes for a North Beach Leather & developing masks, costumes for the Renaissance Faires in Northern & Southern California.

My artwork, whether it be custom jewelry or paintings in oil, acrylic & pastels has exhibited in various WNY venues, including Ellicottville, Lewiston Art Festival & the NT Riverwalk. As an active member of the BNAA, River Art Gallery, the Carnegie Arts Center, the Fine Arts League, as well as an associate Member of the BSA receiving recognition for Best of Show in the Niagara Frontier Art Exhibit at the Kenan Center, Best of Show in the FAL Spring Exhibition in 2021; and the Best of Show in the FAL 2023 Exhibition. Currently the Gallery Manager at River Art Gallery & Gifts in North Tonawanda NY.



Nancy Peterson is a watercolor & oil painter. She grew up in Orchard Park, N.Y. and studied art at Cazenovia College. Nancy became a registered nurse and worked in labor and delivery for many years.

Currently she is the proprietor of the Westfall's Farmhouse Art Studio where artists collaborate in a variety of creative ways.

Kathryn Greene earned a BFA with a concentration in Printmaking at the University at Buffalo in 1999. She worked at Tapir Editions in New York City before returning to pursue post-baccalaureate certification in Art Studies at Buffalo State College. While studying, she worked at Abaca Press and the Arts in Education Institute of WNY. She then taught education at Maryvale Intermediate. In 2004, she began teaching at the Clarence Central School District. In 2008, she earned a Master's Degree in Education at UB. Currently, she is the District Chair of the Art Department and is pursuing a certification in Educational Leadership at Canisius College.

Lauren Trent served as CEPA Gallery's Education Director from 1999 until her retirement in 2022. She is a professional photographer who holds a Masters of Arts and Humanities in Art History/Education, a Bachelor's Degree in Photography (both from the University at Buffalo), and an Associate's Degree in Photography from Villa Maria College. At CEPA, she oversaw the design and implementation of all educational programming, with an emphasis on outreach to diverse communities, including newly resettled refugees, individuals with developmental and learning disabilities, and at-risk youth. Under her direction, CEPA received the 2013 National Arts & Humanities Youth Program Award from the Obama Whitehouse. She has taught photography classes at Villa Maria College, Daemen College, and at the University at Buffalo's Visual Studies Department.

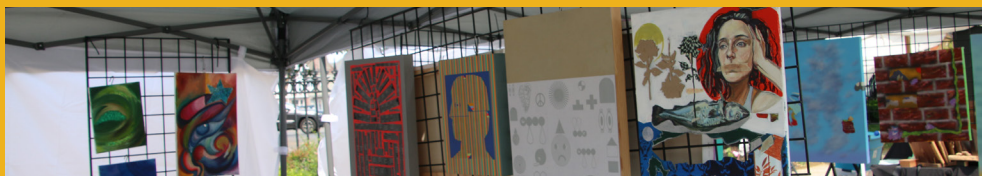
